The Director, ICAR-CIFRI invites online Quotations through Open tenden on e-procurement portal (www.eprocure.gov.in) in **2 (two) Bid Systems** from the Authorized Dealers/reputed firms for the supply of Circular Cage at Farakka Reservoir, West Bengal as per specification at Annexure-III. The tender document and specification details may be downloaded from the Institute’s Website: www.cifri.res.in or e-procurement portal www.eprocure.gov.in. The bidders have to abide by the terms and conditions enclosed at Annexure-I and the specifications mentioned at Annexure-III.

No bid other than online quotation shall be entertained. Bidders need not to submit hard copies and should submit authenticated and valid document through CPP Portal only. However, only Demand Draft for EMD and tender fee as mentioned at para 2 and 4 of Terms and Conditions (Annexure-I) should reach ICAR-Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute, Barrackpore, Kolkata – 700120 within the Bid submission end date and time.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Each bidder should bid in lumpsum through online BOQ. Price must not be quoted in Technical Bid. Rates to be quoted in INR only.
2. The following documents in PDF Format are to be uploaded with the quotation through e-procurement portal www.eprocure.gov.in. No bid other than online quotation shall be entertained. Bidders need not to submit hard copies and should submit authenticated and valid document through CPP Portal only.
 - a) Authenticated PDF Copy of Certificate showing performance of this type of supply in the past e.g. copy of Purchase Order and Challan, certificate issued by Authorized Officer of Department, if any.
 - b) PDF Copy of Demand Drafts (EMD ₹27,000/-). For exemption, authenticated and valid MSME/NSIC/SSI certificate has to be submitted.
 - c) Authenticated PDF copy of Declaration as per Annexure-IV in letter head of the firm.
 - d) Authenticated PDF copy of Technical Bid as per Annexure-II and attachments as mentioned therein, failing which Technical Bid will be rejected.
3. The schedule of supply and specification of items are enclosed in **ANNEXURE-III**. The rate should be quoted on F.O.R. basis at Farakka Reservoir, West Bengal as mentioned in the Tender Notice and specification.
4. Tender documents submitted through online should accompany PDF Copy of Demand Draft of EMD of ₹27,000/-. The EMD fee only in the form of Demand Draft payable at “**ICAR Unit - CIFRI**” payable at SBI, Barrackpore (IFS Code SBIN0000029) may be sent to the Assistant Administrative Officer (Stores), ICAR-CIFRI, Barrackpore, Kolkata-700120 within last date of receipt of tender. In case of non-submission of DD within specified time even for postal delay, quotation will not be considered. The EMD shall be returned to the successful and un-successful bidders as per rules without any interest thereon. The amount of EMD will be forfeited if supply is not effected during the given time and contract will stand cancelled. EMD is exempted for the bidders having MSME/NSIC Certificate.
5. Tender once submitted should remain valid at least for 90 (ninety) days for acceptance.
6. (a) The online bid should contain two envelopes containing the Technical Bid and Financial bid in the form of BOQ.
 - (b) The envelope containing authenticated documents and DDs should be superscribed as “Tender for supply of Circular Cage, West Bengal” as detailed in Notice Inviting e-Tender (NIT).

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8. Rates quoted for the item should include the taxes/duties and transportation cost/delivery cost etc. (on FOR basis) of the items at the mentioned places. Taxes/ duties and transportation cost are to be included in the amount quoted the BOQ and no subsequent claim for taxes/ duties transportation cost etc. will be entertained separately.

9. The PDF copies submitted as Technical Bid on e-procurement portal should be legible. The mistake should be corrected by one stroke and initialed.

10. Incomplete tender and bids not in prescribed format according to the terms and conditions as mentioned hereinabove shall be rejected forthwith.

11. Tax deduction at source will be made wherever applicable.

12. Payment will be released only against the pre-receipted bill indicating the Bank details of the supplier, to be submitted in triplicate within 30 days of supply and installation/commissioning of the items in good condition. Payment will be made through e-payment. The Performance Security of 5% of the cost of the equipment shall have to be submitted by the supplier, which should be valid at least for one year.

13. LIQUIDITY DAMAGES:-

i) In all cases of delay by the supplier in delivery of the materials or any or all of the goods or to perform the services forming the subject matter of this contract beyond the periods specified in purchase order, other than a delay (Force Majure), the buyer shall have the right without prejudice in its other remedies under this contract, to claim liquidated damages amounting to 0.5% per week of the delivery price of the delayed goods or performance of services for each week/month or part thereof of delay until actual delivery or performance. However such damages shall not exceed 10 % of the delivery price of the goods or services of which the delivery or performance has been delayed.

ii) The supplier shall remit the amounts due to Buyer under clause (i) above, within 30 days of receipt of demand from the Buyer. If the supplier fails to make the payment within the period of 30 days, the Buyer shall have the right to recover it from other payments due to the

supplier.

iii) In the event the buyer terminates the Contract, the Buyer shall also have the right to procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, goods or services similar to those undelivered, and the supplier shall be liable to Buyer for any excess cost incurred by the Buyer for procuring such similar goods or services. However, the supplier shall continue performance of the contract to the extent not terminated.

14. The supplier will have to arrange for Road Permit/Way Bill if required for the supply of stores. All the documents required in this regard will be supplied by the Institute.

15. Resolution of disputes:

i) All disputes, these agreements or questions arising out of or in connection with this contract or relating to its construction or performance shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation. If after 90 days the parties have failed to resolve their disputes or differences by mutual discussions, the matter shall be referred by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The Arbitral tribunal shall consist of an arbitrator nominated by the Buyer and another nominated by the supplier. The third arbitrator shall be chosen by the two arbitrators so appointed by the parties and shall act as the presiding arbitrator. In case of failure of two arbitrator appointed by the parties to reach a consensus about the third arbitrator (Presiding arbitrator) within a period of 90 days from the appointment of the arbitrator appointed subsequently, the presiding arbitrator shall be appointed by the Indian Council of Arbitration. The decision of the majority of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties.

ii) The Parties shall continue to perform their obligations under this Contract during the conciliation/arbitration proceedings. The cost of arbitration (including the fees and expenses of the arbitrators) shall be shared equally by the parties, unless the award specifies otherwise.

iii) This article shall survive the termination of this contract.

16. The Director, ICAR-Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute, Barrackpore, Kolkata- 700 120, West Bengal reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders either in part or in full without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

Specification of Circular HDPE Cage

I. HDPE Cage Frame

1. HDPE Cage inner Diameter – 16 m
2. Type – Circular floating cage with 2 floating pipes and hand rail pipe.
Floating Pipe – 250 mm Outer diameter, PE 100 virgin HDPE material, Pipe thickness (14mm) and UV resistant. Railing Pipe – 110 mm Outer diameter, PE 100 virgin HDPE material, Pipe thickness – (14 mm) and UV resistant.
3. Bracket – HDPE injection moulded with inner dia – 250 mm and UV resistant.
4. Railing Height – 1m from floating pipes
5. HDPE cage fitted with stoppers for brackets to hold it in place.
6. More than 25 numbers of Brackets has to be used per cage.
7. HDPE Catwalk should be provided in between two floating pipe

HDPE Cage Nets

1. Fish Net Cage (Grow Out Net) – 320 GSM;16 m diameter; 1+5 m depth; HDPE knotless bream safe netting, Black Colour; 204 PLY; Mesh Size 28MM; Netting UV Yarn; Attached 1 m feed screen from water surface downwards (Polymer screen (75%), GSM: 180 (Anti UV Yarn)).
2. Predator Outer Cage Net –17 m diameter; 6 m depth; Knotted HDPE Twisted netting; 380D; 152 GSM; Dark Blue Colour; 42 PLY; Mesh Size 80MM; Netting UV Yarn; Machine stitch/hand lacing.
3. Anti-Bird Net – 16 m diameter; Knotted HDPE Twisted netting, 29 GSM; Green Colour; Ply size 2 MM; Mesh Size 200mm Netting UV Yarn; Machine stitch.
4. Fingerling Net – 16m dia X 6 m deep; HDPE knotted; 280D; 63 PLY; Mesh size 18 MM.

III. Mooring System

1. 2 mooring aqua ropes - 24mm dia – upto 60m
2. Anchors 125 kg – 2 Nos.
3. Marker Buoy – 2 Nos.
4. 10 kg concrete block with 10mm diameter MS ring (used as ballasts to retain the circular shape of the cage nets) – 16 Nos.
5. HDPE/PP binding rope 10mm – As required.
6. Minimum one year warranty on each individual items after the successful installation of the

cage. The cage should be installed at the site (Farraka) and the cost included the transportation

I. Aqua ropes (specifically designed for cages): Material- PP; Diameter- 14-16 mm; Colour- Light Green.

 5. Vertical ropes – 14 MM Maxima (PP) – 3 str; L. Green– 16 nos. used for fish cage net -16 m diameter; 8 nos. used for Predator outer net -17 m diameter.
 6. Cross ropes – 14 MM Maxima (PP) – 3 str; L. Green – 2 nos. used for Anti-Bird Nets; 8 nos. used for fish cage net -16 m diameter; 8 nos. used for Predator outer net -17 m diameter.
 7. Loops – PVC loops
 8. Hose Pipe - Blue Transparent hose suitable to 12 MM -14 MM Rope.
- Stitching Method: Machine stitch/ hand lacing.
